#### **Manuscript Preparation**

Manuscript must be typed in English language. The text format has to be in Times New Roman with 12 font and 1.5 line spacing. Papers may be organized in the following order: **Materials** Abstract. Introduction, and Methods/Methodology, Discussion, Conclusion and References in APA Format--6<sup>th</sup> Edition. Headings should also be in Times New Roman with 12font (bold). The abstract should be in between 150 to 200 words and the length of the paper should be around 5000 to 6000 words. The references should be written only in the shape of footnotes. However, the font size of the footnotes is 10 in Times New Roman
